Say yes and ask for the number of guests.		Answer A.

2. A is a waitress. B & C are reading the menu.

A	B	C
Ask what B & C would like to drink.	Ask what is available at the restaurant.	
Answer B.	Say that you would like to have a bottle of ____.	Tell A that you would like to have a cup of ____ because (the weather is too hot or you're very thirsty, ...)

3. A is a waitress. B & C are reading the menu.

A	B	C
Ask what B & C would like to order.	Ask C to order.	Say OK and then order veggie dumplings.
Ask in addition to dumplings, what else they would like to order.	Ask if <u>home-style tofu</u> has meat.	
Say that <u>the home-style tofu</u> doesn't have meat.	Tell A that you want (a dish of) <u>home-style tofu</u> .	Say you want two bowls of ____ soup without any MSG.
Repeat what B & C ordered and ask if they want anything else.	Say that you don't want anything else.	
Tell B & C that the food will be ready soon.

Tell B that he/she gives too much/little change.	Apologize.
Say "It's OK."	Say "Goodbye."
