2. Advise people to see a doctor immediately.

Ask what is wrong with B.	Tell A that you haven't been feeling well and you have the following symptoms.
Ask if B took any medicine.	Tell A that you have tried quite a few kinds already, but none of them worked.
Tell B that he/she had better see a doctor right away; otherwise that his/her illness will get worse and worse.	Tell A that seeing a doctor is very costly and also time consuming, and besides you don't have health insurance.
Offer B your advice.	Respond.
